Dear Guest,

The mission of the Fort Bragg Fisher House is to provide a “home away from home” for families of “in-patient” and out-patients like you -- and your family while receiving medical care at the Womack Army Medical Center, at Fort Bragg, N.C. We have put together the following book to assist in making your stay comfortable. We understand how overwhelming things might seem right now, so please don’t hesitate to ask for assistance. We are here to help.

The Fort Bragg Fisher House is different from military billeting and civilian hotels. This is a communal living environment and you are sharing the house with up to ten other families. In order for all of our guests to have an enjoyable stay here, we ask that you abide by the following guidelines:

GUIDELINES:



Smoking and alcoholic beverages inside the Fisher House are strictly forbidden. Please use designated smoking areas outdoors in the backyard only. Please use ashtrays on outdoor tables. If there are no ashtrays, please ask Management for an ashtray. Alcohol consumption on Fisher House property is strictly prohibited. You will be asked to leave if these regulations are broken by yourself or family member.



Food and drinks are allowed in the kitchen and dining areas only. Eating & drinking in rooms is not allowed. For any personal food items you may bring or purchase during your stay we offer personal refrigerator,

freezer and secure cupboard space for storage in the kitchen.



Children must be supervised by an adult at all times. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for any damages caused by their children during their stay in the house. Please be sure to clean up after your child uses the play room. Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult at all times.



Pets are strictly forbidden. Due to allergies and other concerns, pets are not permitted in the house or anywhere on Fisher House grounds.



Checkout is at 10:00 a.m. Please notify staff of your departure date as soon as possible, along with any changes on the day of your planned departure. *If you are leaving outside normal business hours please put your key in the drop-box outside the office door. Additionally, follow the check-out sheet provided in this book.*



Out patients may stay at the Fisher House under certain circumstances:

- The day prior to their appointment, procedure, and/or surgery.
- They must have consistent appointments and not have gaps of more than two days between appointments to stay at the Fisher House. If surgery, chemotherapy, and/or any other treatment or procedure necessitates a patient to have an advocate to help with activities of daily living (ADL) they must plan in advance and bring an adult escort with them.
- Management reserves the right to require a non-medical attendant to be present for the duration of the stay and at any time before arriving or during the outpatient stay in BRFH. Furthermore, Management reserves the right to make the determination if the BRFH is able to accommodate an outpatient.
- Patients discharged directly from the hospital are NOT eligible to stay at the Fisher House due to infection control concerns. Families of patients must check out the morning of the patient's discharge from the hospital and may not be brought over to the Fisher House while family checks out of the Fisher House.
- Fisher House does NOT accept patients on pass.
